RESOLUTION

LAGOS, J:

This treats of the "APPLICATION FOR PROBATION" dated November 10, 2016 filed by accused John Giseler F. Imperial, who was convicted of the instant charge for violation of Article 210 of the Revised Penal Code (Direct Bribery) in Criminal Case No. SB-13-CRM-0289 per Court's Decision promulgated on November 3, 2016. Accused was sentenced to suffer the penalty of indeterminate imprisonment of Two (2) Years of Prison Correctional as minimum to Two (2) Years Eleven (11) Months and Ten (10) Days of Prison Correctional as Maximum and to pay a Fine of Twenty Thousand (P20,000.00) Pesos.

In Compliance with the Resolution of the Court dated January 23, 2017, Supervising Probation and Parole Officer Jeanette S. Santiagué, submitted a Post-Sentence Investigation Report dated March 3, 2017 which bears the approval of Chief Probation and Parole Officer Teodoro D. Villaverde, recommending the approval of accused's probation in this case.

After having evaluated the Post-Sentence Investigation Report, the Court finds the recommendation therein for the granting of the probation of the accused to be in order.

WHEREFORE, the application for probation of accused John Giseler F. Imperial is GRANTED. The accused shall undergo probation, under the following conditions which he must comply, to wit:


* Sitting as Special Member per Administrative Order No. 025-2017, dated February 1, 2017.

* Sitting as Special Member per Administrative Order No. 226-2017, dated June 15, 2017.

1. The probation shall be for a period of One (1) Year, to be counted from Probationer's initial report for supervision;
2. Probationer shall report initially to the Chief Probation and Parole Officer at Las Piñas City Parole and Probation Office, Ground Floor, Hall of Justice Bldg., Las Piñas City within Seventy-Two (72) hours from receipt of the Order granting Probation;
3. He shall, thereafter, report to his Supervising Probation and Parole Officer at least ONCE A MONTH, unless otherwise modified by the Chief Probation and Parole Officer or Court, as the case may be;
4. He shall reside at ^{led} ~~19~~ **Veraville Executive Homes, Pamplona Dos, Las Piñas City** and shall not change his residence without prior approval of the Supervising Probation and Parole Officer, or Court, as the case may be;
5. He shall secure a written permit to travel outside the jurisdiction of the Chief Probation and Parole Office from the Chief Probation and Parole Officer and from the Court, if such travel exceeds thirty (30) days;
6. He shall not commit any crime or any other offense;
7. He shall render community service and will participate in tree-planting activities;
8. He shall allow the Supervising Probation and Parole Officer or an authorized Volunteer Aide to visit his home and place of work;
9. He shall meet his family responsibilities;
10. He shall undergo medical, psychological or psychiatric examination and treatment and enter and remain in a specified institution, when required for that purpose;



11. He shall devote himself to a specific employment and shall not change said employment without prior notice to the supervising officer and/or pursue a prescribed secular study or vocational training;
12. He shall refrain from associating with persons of questionable character, and shall not commit any crime or any other offense;
13. He shall cooperate with his program of supervision, and shall satisfy any other condition related to his rehabilitation and not unduly restrictive of his liberty incompatible with his freedom of conscience.

In the event the Petitioner fails to observe the preceding conditions and/or has committed any material misrepresentation in his application for probation, his probation may be revoked by the Court or the conditions thereof modified.


