PROBATION ORDER

Accused Kadil Mukamad Guiamad filed an Application for Probation after being convicted in a Decision¹ of this Court promulgated on July 30, 2014, the dispositive portion of which reads as follows:

WHEREFORE, premises considered, judgment is hereby rendered as follows:

XXX

In Criminal Case No. SB-07-CRM-0009, the Court finds accused Kadil M. Guiamad guilty beyond reasonable doubt of Violation of Section 5(a) in relation to Section 52(g) of Republic Act No. 8291, also known as "The Government Insurance Service Insurance Act of 1997." He is hereby sentenced to suffer the penalty of imprisonment of five (5) years and ordered to pay a fine of Twenty Thousand Pesos (P20,000.00). In addition, he shall suffer perpetual absolute disqualification from holding public office and from practicing any profession or calling licensed by the government.


SO ORDERED.

Based on the recommendation² of Probation and Parole Officer II **Benjamin G. Mamaril**, which was approved by Supervising Probation and Parole Officer **Romeo G. Cachin**, that accused be placed on probation, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the execution of sentence of said accused be suspended and that he be placed on probation for a period of SIX (6) MONTHS from the date of the issuance of this Resolution in accordance with the provisions of the Probation Law of 1976, as amended by Presidential Decree No. 1990, under the following terms and conditions:

1. Probationer shall report initially to the Chief Probation and Parole Officer at Quezon City Parole and Probation Office No. 2 within seventy-two (72) hours from the receipt of the Order granting probation
2. He shall, thereafter, report to his supervising Probation and Parole Officer Twice a month unless otherwise modified by the Chief Probation and Parole Officer.


3. He shall reside at 76 Rosal Street, Barangay Rosary Heights 7, Cotabato City and shall not change his residence without prior approval of the Chief Probation and Parole Officer, or Court, as the Case may be.
4. He shall secure a written permit to travel outside the jurisdiction of the Parole and Probation Office from the Chief Probation and Parole Officer and from the Court if such travel exceeds thirty (30) days.
5. He shall not commit any crime or any offenses.
6. He shall render community service and will participate in tree-planting activities.
7. He shall allow the supervising Probation and Parole Officer or an authorized Volunteer Probation Aide to visit his home and place of work.
8. He shall continue to meet his/her family responsibilities.
9. He shall undergo medical, psychological or psychiatric examination and treatment and enter and remain in a specified institution , when required for that purpose.
10. He shall devote himself to a specific employment and shall not change said employment without prior notice to the supervising officer and/or pursue a prescribed secular study or vocational training.
11. He shall refrain from associating with persons of questionable character.
12. He shall cooperate with his program of supervision, and shall satisfy any other condition related to his rehabilitation and not unduly restrictive of his liberty incompatible with his freedom of conscience.

WHEREFORE, probationer **KADIL MUKAMAD GUIAMAD** is directed to strictly comply with the preceding terms and conditions. In the event that the probationer fails to observe the preceding conditions and/or has committed any material misrepresentation in his application for probation, the Court shall revoke and/or modify this Probation Order, and the Probationer shall be made to serve the sentence originally imposed.

Pursuant to Section 13, paragraph 2 of the Probation Act of 1976, as amended by Presidential Decree No. 1990, and considering that he resides at 76 Rosal Street, Barangay Rosary Heights 7, Cotabato City, control over the Probationer is hereby transferred to the Executive Judge of the Regional Trial Court, Cotabato City and to Cotabato City Parole and Probation Office, respectively. Copies of all orders or resolutions that may be issued in connection herewith, especially the final order of discharge provided for in Section 16, P.D. No. 968, as amended, shall be furnished to this Court. Likewise, copies of all quarterly probation reports as well as the final probation report to be submitted to the Executive Judge by the Cotabato City Parole and Probation Office shall also be furnished by said office to this Court.
