**O R D E R**

In today's scheduled hearing, the accused appeared with his counsel, Atty. Dexter A. Francisco. The accused with the assistance of his counsel moved to withdraw his previous plea of not guilty. After confirming from the accused and Atty. Francisco that accused Ibrahim is fully cognizant of the consequences of the withdrawal of his previous plea, the Court GRANTED the same. The plea of "not guilty" to the charge of Violation of Article 218 of the Revised Penal Code is considered withdrawn.

Thereafter, the Court proceeded with the re-arraignment of the accused in consonance with the plea bargaining agreement of the parties, as approved by Ombudsman Conchita Carpio-Morales and Special Prosecutor Edilberto Sandoval. Upon re-arraignment for **Violation of Section 89 of P.D. No. 1445**, by reading the Information in English, a language known and understood by him, accused, Hanafi Abdullatip Ibrahim, assisted by his counsel, entered a plea of **GUILTY**.

When queried, accused Ibrahim and his counsel confirmed that the accused fully understands the nature and consequences of entering a plea of guilty to the crime charged.

Having pleaded guilty to the crime for the acts alleged in the Information, accused Ibrahim is deemed to have admitted all the material facts alleged therein.

WHEREFORE, judgment is hereby rendered finding the accused **GUILTY** beyond reasonable doubt for Violation of Section 89 of P.D. 1445. He is hereby sentenced to pay a penalty of fine in the amount of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00). In case of insolvency, he shall be required to undergo subsidiary imprisonment. There being no civil liability involved, as the Prosecution confirmed that the accused has satisfactorily liquidated the amount involved in this case, no award of damages is made. The fine is payable within five (5) days from today.
