MINUTES of the proceedings held June 21, 2018

The following resolution was adopted:

SB-17-CRM-1185 and 1186 –

PEOPLE vs. FELIPE G. PICAZO, ET AL.

This resolves the *Motion to Release Cash Bond and Release the Original Receipt Evidencing Payment*¹ filed by accused Felipe G. Picazo, Rodolfo L. Daligues and Conrado G. Ganaden.

In the Resolution dated November 21, 2017,² this Court dismissed the present cases against said accused. The dispositive portion of said Resolution reads:

WHEREFORE, The Motion for Consolidation is **DENIED** for lack of merit.

x x x

The Motion to Dismiss on the ground of violation of right to speedy disposition of cases is, however, **GRANTED**. Accordingly, these cases are ordered **DISMISSED**.

Since the circumstance of these cases are applicable to accused Rodolfo L. Daligues, the **DISMISSAL** will also benefit him despite his non-inclusion in the present motions.

The hold departure order issued against accused Felipe G. Picazo and Conrado G. Ganaden is hereby **LIFTED**, and the bonds separately posted by them are hereby **RELEASED**, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

This Court reiterates its order in the said Resolution insofar as the release of the bonds posted by accused Picazo and Ganaden is concerned. Considering that the present cases were also dismissed as to accused Daligues, the Court hereby directs the RELEASE of the bond posted by accused Daligues, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures, and the LIFTING of the hold departure order issued against him by reason of these cases. Finally, as prayed for, the original Official Receipts No. 9144199B and 9144197B (accused Picazo), 9144200B and 9144198B (accused Ganaden), and 3637470C and 3637471C (accused Daligues) are hereby RELEASED.


