During the hearing on September 20, 2017, Atty. Amor Venenoso and Atty. Glorydee A. Comparativo, counsels for accused Efren U. Anggo, informed this Court of accused Anggo's death.

In its Order dated September 20, 2017,<sup>1</sup> the Court directed the prosecution and the counsels for accused Anggo to submit proof of the alleged death of said accused within 30 days from notice.

On May 31, 2018, the prosecution filed the *Manifestation and Compliance*, together with the Certificate of Death with Registry No. 2017-16583 issued by the Philippine Statistics Authority.

The said Certificate of Death shows that one **EFREN UNGGUI ANGGU** passed away on September 18, 2017.

It appears from the foregoing that the death of accused Anggo was sufficiently established.

On the other hand, the records show that there was no compliance on the part of Atty. Venenoso and Atty. Comparativo with this Court's September 20, 2017 Order.

**WHEREFORE**, pursuant to Article 89 of the Revised Penal Code, the case against accused Efren Unggui Anggo is **DISMISSED**.

The cash bail bond of accused Anggo, in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Pesos (PhP15,000.00), as evidenced by Official Receipt No. 20819276 dated September 15, 2004, is hereby **ORDERED** released to the heirs of accused Anggo, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures. The Hold Departure Order dated September 9, 2003 issued against accused Anggo is hereby **LIFTED**.

Let a copy of this Resolution be furnished the Bureau of Immigration.


