The following resolution was adopted:

SB-15-CRM-0252 to 0279 – PEOPLE vs. RAUL D. PETRASANTA, ET AL.

The Court **NOTES** the *Compliance* filed on July 12, 2018 by accused P/Supt. Regino S. Catiis, stating that (i) he arrived in the Philippines, from Malaysia and Singapore, on July 8, 2018 at 2:00 am instead of on July 7, 2018 (as authorized by the Court) due to the delay in his return flight; and, (ii) he personally appeared before the Division Clerk of Court, Atty. Mary Ruth M. Ferrer, on July 9, 2018.¹

On the other hand, considering that the prosecution did not interpose any objection thereto, the *Motion to Release Travel Cash Bond* filed by accused Catiis is **GRANTED**. The travel bond of accused Catiis in the amount of One Hundred Eighty Thousand Pesos (PhP180,000.00), as evidenced by Official Receipt No. 5497338 V dated June 28, 2018, is hereby **ORDERED** released, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.


