The following resolution was adopted:

SB-17-CRM-2138 and 2139 –

PEOPLE vs. ENRICO R. ECHIVERRI, ET AL.

Accused Edna V. Centeno and Jesusa C. Garcia filed their *Motion for Partial Reconsideration*¹ of this Court's Resolution dated October 23, 2018.² The prosecution opposed³ said accused' Motion, pointing out that the facts, documents, and witnesses mentioned in said Motion do not pertain to the present case. Thereafter, realizing that their Motion, due to oversight, referred to documents pertaining to a different case, accused Centeno and Garcia sought the admission⁴ of their *Amended Motion for Partial Reconsideration*.⁵

It appearing that the amendments to accused Centeno and Garcia's *Motion for Partial Reconsideration* merely corrected the clerical errors pertaining to the factual averments therein, and that their arguments remain unchanged, this Court resolves to **GRANT** said accused' *Motion to Admit*, and hereby **ADMITS** their *Amended Motion for Partial Reconsideration*.

The prosecution is given a period of five (5) days from receipt of this resolution within which to file its comment/opposition to said *Amended Motion for Partial Reconsideration*. Thereafter, the incident is deemed submitted for resolution.


