The following resolution was adopted in the following cases:

**Crim. Cases No. SB-08-CRM-0270 and SB-12-CRM-0006 -
PEOPLE VS. ROBERT LALA, ET AL.**

The Manifestation filed by accused Gerardo Surla on January 23, 2019 relative to his travel abroad is only NOTED, it appearing that the said accused violated the terms and conditions of his travel authority because he presented himself to the Division Clerk of Court only on January 10, 2019, or one (1) day late, allegedly due to oversight. His compliance was also filed two (2) days late as it was due on January 21, 2019, the last day – January 19, 2019, being a Saturday.

Further review of the record reveals that accused Surla violated the terms and conditions of his Travel Authority dated April 4, 2018 as he did not file his compliance after his travel to Japan on April 15 to 23, 2018.

In view of the foregoing violations committed by accused Surla, he is ordered to **show cause**, within five (5) days from receipt hereof, why his travel bond should not be forfeited in favor of the government for his repeated failure to faithfully comply with the terms and conditions of his travels abroad.
