RESOLUTION



MUSNGI, J.:

On 17 October 2018, accused Teresita Demabasa filed her *Omnibus Motion*,¹ praying for the Court to conduct her arraignment in Naga City, Camarines Sur as she cannot travel due to her ailing health.

Accused Demabasa manifested that she was advised by her doctor to refrain from long travel and strenuous physical activity as she has been diagnosed to have a coronary artery disease, status post coronary artery bypass graft surgery and with difficulty in ambulation due to dysequilibrium and with peripheral arterial diseases which causes her legs to swell and be painful.

In order to prover her medical condition, she allegedly attached a Medical Certificate obtained from her physician, Dr. Roy C. Fernando. It appears, however, that such Medical Certificate was not furnished the Court nor attached in her instant motion.




