The following resolution was adopted:

SB-17-CRM-1593 to 1596 –

PEOPLE vs. RODOLFO W. ANTONINO, ET AL.

In the higher interest of substantial justice, and considering that the Pre-trial Order has not yet been issued, the Court resolves to **GRANT** the prosecution's *Motion to Admit Supplemental Pre-trial Brief*,¹ over the objection of accused Rodolfo W. Antonino.² During the hearing on February 19, 2019, accused Encarnita-Cristina Potian Munsod was given three (3) days within which to file her comment. However, the Court has not received the same, and hence, she is deemed to have waived her right to file her comment.


