The following resolution was adopted:

**SB-18-CRM-0240 to 0243** –

**PEOPLE vs. AL C. ARGOSINO, ET AL.**

It appearing from the testimonies of Dr. George F. Gomez and Chief Inspector Ana Liza Cabras that there is a need for accused Wenceslao A. Sombero, Jr. to undergo the necessary dental procedures,<sup>1</sup> including the taking of a panoramic x-ray; that the same cannot be performed within the Quezon City Jail-Annex;<sup>2</sup> and there being no objection from the prosecution, the Court resolves to ***GRANT*** accused Sombero's *Amended Motion for Leave to Undergo Dental Procedures*.<sup>3</sup>

Accordingly, accused Sombero is allowed on March 26, 2019, at 12:00 noon, to be brought to Rosero Dental Clinic, Room 711, Medical Office Building, Asian Hospital and Medical Center, 2205 Civic Drive, Filinvest Corporate City, Alabang, Muntinlupa, to undergo the necessary dental procedures, from 1:00 P.M. to 5:00 P.M.

Said dental procedures shall be done at accused Sombero's own expense. He shall likewise shoulder the costs of his security and transportation to and from the aforementioned address. He must be brought back to the Quezon City Jail-Annex on the same day immediately after said dental procedures.

Dr. Leandro E. Rosero, Dr. George F. Gomez, and Jail Chief Inspector Ana Liza Cabras are ***DIRECTED*** to submit to the Court their respective reports within five (5) days from the conduct of said dental procedures.


