**PP vs. HERNANDO LALISAN SIBUGAN,**  
**ET AL.,**



Upon perusal of the records, during the last hearing of these cases on January 31, 2018, it was revealed that a **Warrant of Arrest** had been issued against accused Marlind Marcelo and the **cash bond** he posted for his provisional liberty was already **cancelled**. On March 23, 2018, as per **return** of the Warrant of Arrest from SPO2 Cesar M. Cariaga of the Warrant Section of the Philippine National Police Regional Office I, Balaoan Police Station, to wit: "**subject person was no longer located at the given address**" which was noted by this Court on even date.

On March 25, 2019, the **return** of the **Warrant of Arrest** issued on January 31, 2017 against accused **Hernando Lalisan Sibugan, Marlind Lopez Marcelo, Maria Deposo Camanay, Amelia Carmela Constantino Zoleta, Renante Limansa Dialawi** and **Arpha Dialawa** states that: "*after diligent effort exerted by this command (SI Jeffrey A. Moqueda, Special Investigator III), (sic) cannot be located at his given address or elsewhere.*"

WHEREFORE, LET an *Alias Warrant of Arrest* be issued against the said accused **Hernando Lalisan Sibugan, Marlind Lopez Marcelo, Maria Deposo Camanay, Amelia Carmela Constantino Zoleta, Renante Limansa Dialawi** and **Arpha Dialawa**. The Director of the National Bureau of Investigation, Taft Avenue, Manila, the Chief of the Philippine National Police-Criminal Investigation and Detection Group (PNP-CIDG), Camp Crame, Quezon City and all other authorities or agencies enforced to serve these warrants are **ORDERED** to make a return thereon within thirty (30) days from receipt hereof.

In the meantime, let these cases be **ARCHIVED** without prejudice to their revival upon apprehension of said accused.

In view thereof, the prosecution's *Ex-Parte Manifestation* filed on February 15, 2017 informing the Court that its "Motion to Admit Amended Information" was already considered submitted for Resolution per Order dated March 9, 2012, is merely **NOTED**.
