The following resolution was adopted:

SB-17-CRM-2138 and 2139 –

PEOPLE vs. ENRICO R. ECHIVERRI, ET AL.

This Court resolves to **GRANT** the *Amended Motion for Partial Reconsideration*¹ filed by accused Edna V. Centeno and Jesusa C. Garcia, over the objection of the prosecution,² it appearing that said accused' filing of their demurrer will not be done merely to stall the proceedings.³

Accused Centeno and Garcia are given a non-extendible period of ten (10) days from the receipt of this Resolution within which to file their demurrer to evidence in **SB-17-CRM-2139**. Similarly, the prosecution is given a non-extendible period of ten (10) days from the receipt of said accused' demurrer to evidence within which to file its comment/opposition thereto. Thereafter, the incident is deemed submitted for resolution.
