MINUTES of the proceedings held on October 21, 2019

The following resolution was adopted:

SB-16-CRM-0118 to 0119 PEOPLE vs. AMADO T. ESPINO, JR. ET AL.

This resolves the following:

1. *Motion to Release Travel Bond*¹ filed by accused Cynthia D. Camara, Ann Lyn P. Detera, and Denise Ann P. Sia Kho Po;
2. *Motion*² filed by accused Ann Lynn P. Detera;
3. *Comment (Re: Motion to Release Travel Bond of accused Cynthia D. Camara, Ann Lyn P. Detera, and Denise Ann P. Sia Kho Po)*³ filed by the prosecution; and,
4. *Comment (Re: Motion dated 24 July 2019 of Accused Ann Lynn P. Detera)*⁴ filed by the prosecution.

In their *Motion to Release Travel Bond*,⁵ accused Cynthia D. Camara, Ann Lynn P. Detera, and, Denise Ann P. Sia Kho Po, ask the Court to release their respective travel bonds in view of the Court's *Order* dated January 28, 2019, granting their *Demurrer to Evidence* and dismissing the charges against them.⁶

Accused Detera also filed a *Motion*,⁷ manifesting that ANN LYNN PUJOL DETERA is one and the same person as ANNLYN PUJOL DETERA, who was arraigned, tried and acquitted in this case. She asks the Court to (a) correct her

name from ANNLYN PUJOL DETERA, as it appears from the records of the case, to ANN LYNN PUJOL DETERA, and (b) release her travel bond.⁸

The prosecution, in its *Comment*, interposed no objection to accused Detera and Sia Kho Po's *Motion to Release Travel Bond*, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedure.⁹

The prosecution likewise interposed no objection to accused Detera's *Motion*.¹⁰


THE COURT'S RULING

The Court **NOTES** accused Detera's manifestation that ANN LYNN PUJOL DETERA and ANNLYN PUJOL DETERA, are the same person and the accused in this case.

The Court simply **NOTES** accused Camara's *Motion to Release Travel Bond*, there being no record that accused Camara posted travel bond in the course of trial.

On the other hand, there being no opposition from the prosecution, the Court **GRANTS** the *Motion to Release Travel Bond* filed by accused Annlyn P. Detera/Ann Lynn P. Detera and Denise Ann P. Sia Kho Po, the cases against them having been dismissed in the Court's *Decision* dated January 28, 2019.¹¹ The records confirm that both accused Annlyn P. Detera/Ann Lynn P. Detera and Denise Ann P. Sia Kho Po have complied with the conditions imposed by the Court in its *Resolutions* dated May 9, 2018¹² and May 2, 2018,¹³ respectively. Accordingly, the following are ordered released, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedure:

1. To Annlyn P. Detera/Ann Lynn P. Detera or her duly authorized representative, her travel bond in the amount of Sixty Thousand Pesos (PhP60,000.00), evidenced by O.R. No. 5497175 V;¹⁴ and,
2. To Denise Ann P. Sia Kho Po or her duly authorized representative, her travel bond in the total amount of Sixty Thousand Pesos (PhP60,000.00), as follows:
 - (1) Thirty Thousand Pesos (PhP30,000.00), evidenced by O.R. No. 5497169 V;¹⁵ and,
 - (2) Thirty Thousand Pesos (PhP30,000.00), evidenced by O.R. No. 7381418 O.¹⁶


