The following resolution was adopted in the following case:

**Crim. Case No. SB-18-CRM-0101** – **PEOPLE VS. ANTONIO DEL ROSARIO FLOIRENDO, JR.**

Considering that accused Antonio del Rosario Floirendo, Jr. has timely filed his *Notice of Appeal with Manifestation*<sup>1</sup> on January 29, 2021,<sup>2</sup> and has paid the docket and other legal fees of Three Thousand and Thirty-Five Pesos (PhP3,035.00),<sup>3</sup> his *Notice of Appeal* is hereby **APPROVED** and given due course.<sup>4</sup>

The Court *NOTES* accused Floirendo's *Manifestation* that the Court allowed him to enjoy provisional liberty under the same bond pending appeal, there being no objection thereto by the Prosecution.
