MINUTES of the Proceedings held on April 18, 2022

The following resolution was adopted in the following cases:

***Crim. Cases No. SB-18-CRM-0337 to 0339 – PEOPLE VS. EDGAR RAMA, ET AL.***

On April 12, 2022, this Court received from the Judicial Records Office of the Supreme Court a *Letter of Transmittal*<sup>1</sup> together with a copy of the *Decision*<sup>2</sup> and a certified true copy of the *Entry of Judgment* in *Nancy A. Catamco (Formerly Nancy C. Catamco) vs. Sandiganbayan Sixth Division; Office of the Ombudsman; and People of the Philippines* (G.R. Nos. 243560-62) and *Pompey M. Perez vs. Sandiganbayan (Sixth Division)* (G.R. No. 243261-63).

The *Decision* annulled and set aside this Court's *Resolutions* dated August 7, 2018 and October 12, 2018, and ordered the dismissal of the present cases against herein accused Nancy A. Catamco and accused Pompey M. Perez for violation of their constitutional right to speedy disposition of cases. The *Decision* became *final and executory* on December 15, 2020, per *Entry of Judgment* issued by the Judicial Records Office of the Supreme Court.

In view thereof, the instant cases are ordered **DISMISSED** against accused Nancy A. Catamco and accused Pompey M. Perez.

The cash bonds posted by accused Catamco<sup>3</sup> and accused Perez<sup>4</sup> for their provisional liberty are ordered **RELEASED**, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures. Likewise, as prayed for by accused Perez,<sup>5</sup> his travel bond<sup>6</sup> is ordered **RELEASED**, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

The *Hold Departure Order* dated May 7, 2018 issued against accused Catamco and accused Perez is hereby ordered **LIFTED** and **SET ASIDE**.


The cases against accused Carcellar, Estrera, Jr. and Dorog are likewise ordered **ARCHIVED** pending their arrests.

Furnish the Bureau of Immigration with a copy of this *Resolution*.


