RESOLUTION

It appearing from the record of the above-entitled cases that accused **Bibiana T. Cruz** (in SB-14-CRM-0113) and **Victor B. Sia** (in SB-14-CRM-0113) have remained at large despite delivery to the proper peace officers of the Warrants of Arrest¹ dated 20 December 2017 and 11 February 2014 issued by the Court, let these cases be archived, without prejudice to their revival upon the arrest or voluntary surrender of said accused.

The Chief of the Warrant Section of the Quezon City Police District is directed to explain why accused Bibiana T. Cruz has not been apprehended; and the Chief of the Warrant Section of PNP-NCRPO is likewise directed to explain why accused Victor B. Sia has not been apprehended.

Let alias warrants of arrest be issued against **Victor B. Sia and Bibiana T. Cruz.**
